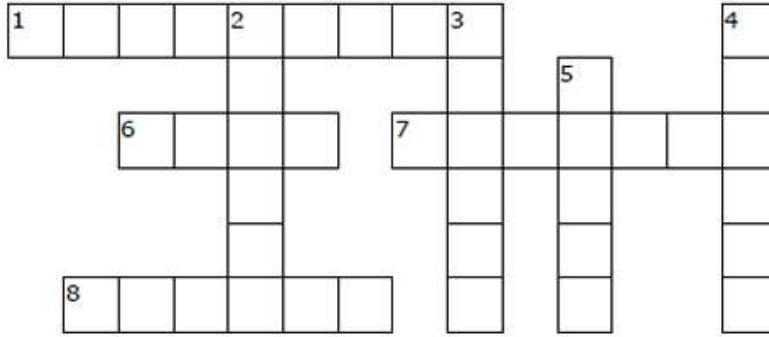





Jesus' Baptism

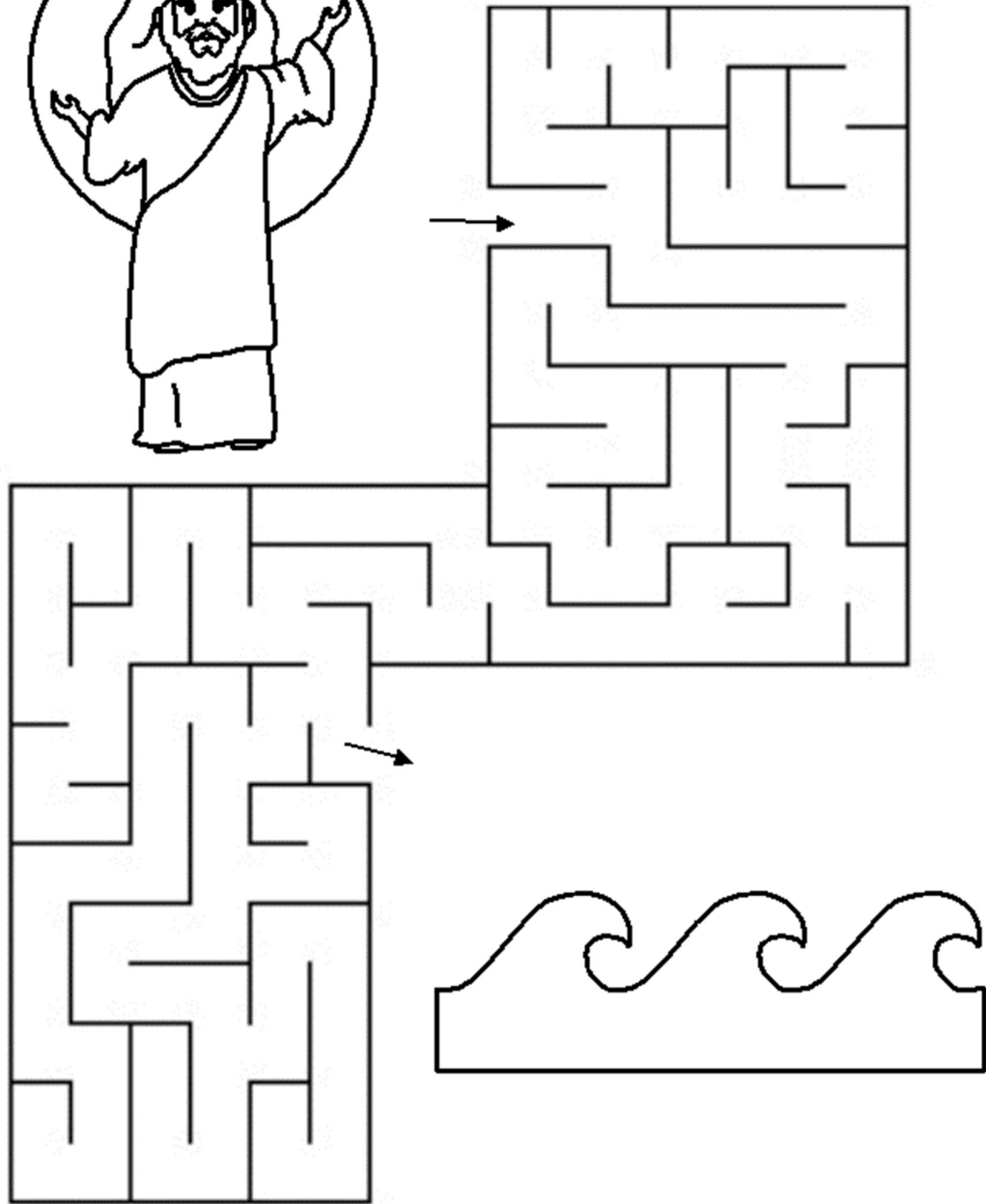

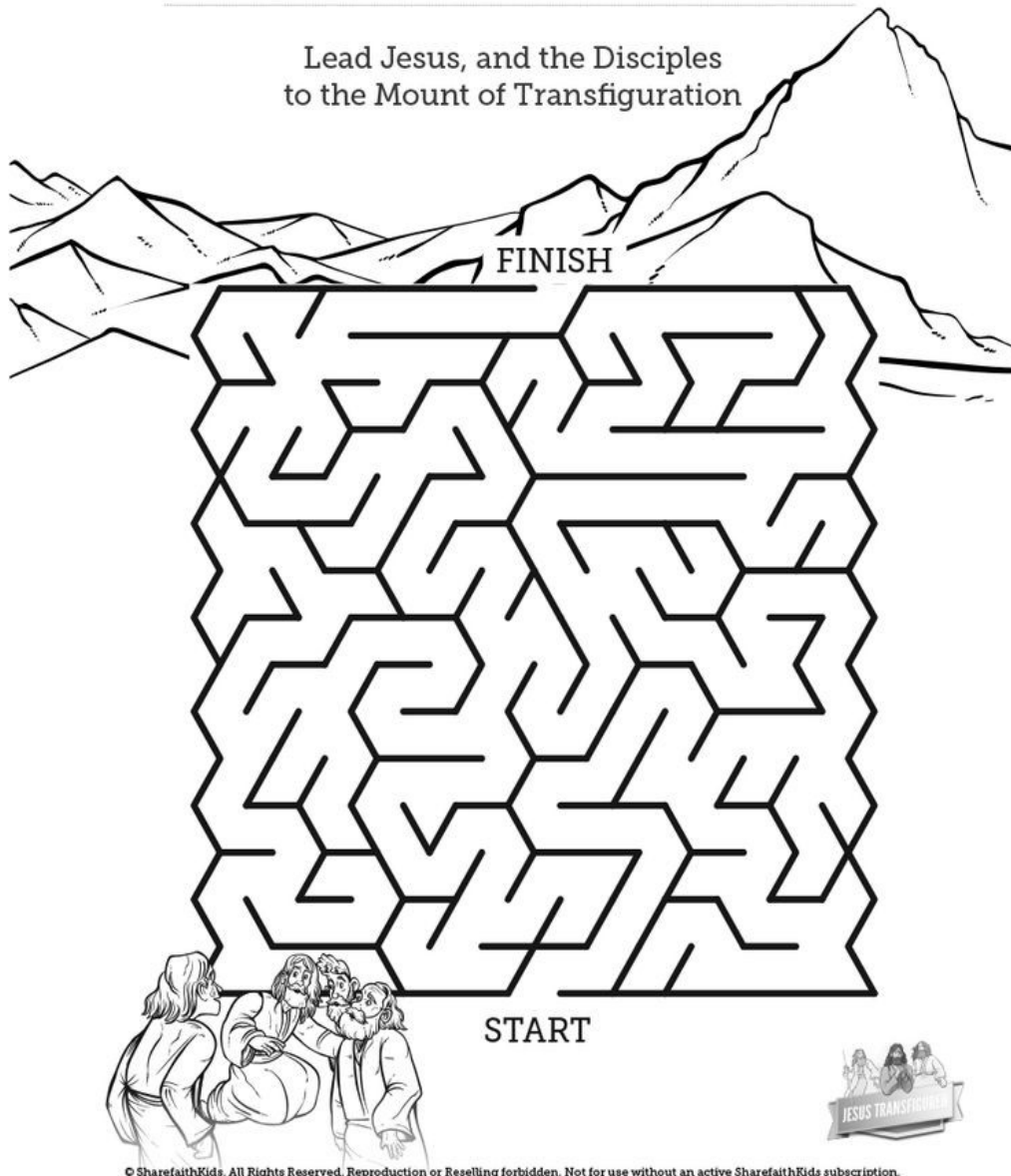

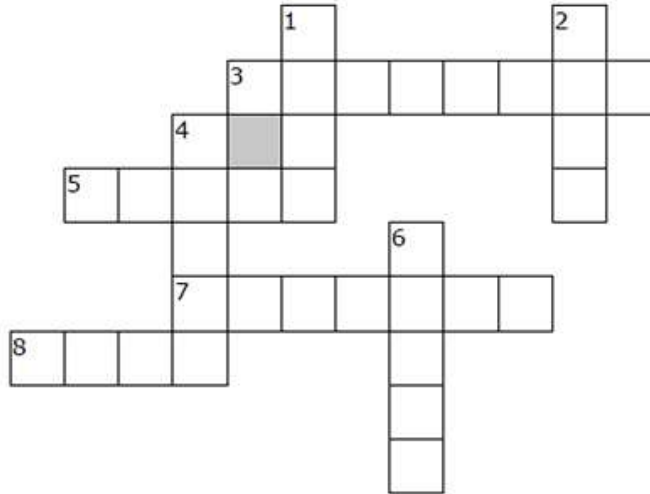
