NURSERY & RECEPTION, YEAR 1 & 2

Theme: Worship

This month we are thinking about worship. We have a time of worship every week when we sing songs to God. But why? We are going to be thinking about why and how we worship God. During this month, some people are going to help us learn different ways we can worship God.

There are so many verses in the Bible that talk about singing and dancing for God! It might seem a little strange that we use our voices, but all we're doing it saying to God how much we love him!	
The verse above says "I will sing of the Lord's great love forever" there is something so special about singing about God's love and also our love back to him.	Second verse:
Isaiah 42:10 says "Sing to the Lord a new song, his praise from the ends of the earth, you who go down to the sea and all that is in it, you islands, and all who live in them". This verse talks about all the people and all that's in the oceans and on islands! You could write a song to God thanking him for all that he has made like whales and fish and animals!	
Worship and Pray

Pray: Write the name of someone you would like to pray for on a lolly stick or strip of paper. Pray for them and then pop the stick/paper in a pot or container. Over the next few days, repeat this until you have a pot with a few different names. You can now pick a different stick and pray for someone different each time you gather to pray.
